

THE KAPLAN–MEIER PRESENTATION CHECKLIST

Twelve checks before a survival curve leaves your building.

THE DENOMINATOR

1. The number-at-risk row is present.
2. It is legible at projection scale — minimum 10pt at 16:9, tested on the room's screen and not on a laptop.
3. The analysis population is named on the chart, with its size.
4. Where the analysis population differs from enrolment, the chart says why.

THE CURVE

5. Censoring marks are visible. Their absence implies complete follow-up that does not exist.
6. The y-axis starts at zero, or the truncation is explicitly marked.
7. The x-axis extends only as far as the data reasonably support. Tails computed on a handful of patients are labelled as such or cut.
8. Median values are stated with their confidence intervals, not as bare point estimates.

THE COMPARISON

9. If two curves appear, the comparative statistic appears with them — on the chart, not on the source slide it was lifted from.
10. If no statistical test was performed, the chart says so explicitly.
11. The comparator is named in full, including line of therapy and setting.

THE READER

12. The figure survives greyscale and the three common colour-vision deficiencies. Check it before you check anything else — roughly one in twelve men has some form of colour-vision deficiency, and in a room of twenty clinicians that is not a hypothetical.

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
